The Council considered the Letter no.K-11053/221/2023-LH (26918) dated 12.1.20226 received from the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, New Delhi regarding Condonation of delay in submission of application (Form-I) for Letter of Intent (LOI) together with the Inspection Report in respect of College of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Datia, Madhya Pradesh under Rani Lakshmi Bai Central Agricultural University, Jhansi and the recommendations made by the Executive Committee in their meetings held on 18/2/2026.

The Council has gone through the inspection report, observation of the Executive Committee meeting dated 18.2.2026 as well as comments furnished by the Registrar, Rani Lakshmi Bai Central Agricultural University, Jhansi. The observation of the Council is as under:

- There is no sanctioned post of Professor.
- There is a shortage of 04 Asstt. Professor.
- As per VCI MSVE Regulations, 2016, 100 Cow/ Buffalo are required, whereas College has only 31 Cow/ Buffalo.
- OPD and IPD are deficient in terms of indoor and outdoor patents.

In view of above, Council decided to recommend to the Central Government for issue of Letter of Intent (LOI) for the academic session 2026-27 and 2027-28 for 80 annual admissions to the B.VSc & AH course as per rule 7(9) of VCI Rules, 2017 subject to the condition that the concerned University shall inform the status of sanctioned post of Professor to the Central Government for their consideration. Further, the recommendation of LOI is also subject to the condition that the authorities of the University has to fulfil the aforesaid deficiencies before the issue of Letter of Permission for which Council shall again verify the facilities in terms of fulfilment of aforesaid deficiencies before recommendation of Letter of Permission (LOP) to the Central Government.

It was further decided that the copy of the inspection report as well as comments received from the University shall also be forwarded to the Central Government as provided under Rule 7(8) of VCI Rules, 2017 with recommendation for issue of LOI.

The Council has gone through the inspection report, observation of the Executive Committee meeting dated 18.2.2026 as well as comments furnished by the Registrar, Bihar Animal Science University, Patna. The Council observed that the applicant college fulfils the minimum requirements in terms of land, building, infrastructure facilities, LFC, VCC, laboratories and library facility as provided under VCI Rules, 2017 read with VCI Regulations, 2016. However, there is a shortage of teaching manpower in terms of Professor in 04 departments.

Hence, Council decided to recommend to the Central Government for issue of Renewal of Letter of Permission for the Third and Fourth B.V.Sc.&A.H programme commencing from the academic session 2025-26 and 2026-27 in respect of College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Kishanganj, Bihar under Bihar Animal Science University, Patna as provided under rule 9(8) of VCI Rules, 2017 with the condition that the University shall make appointment of four Professor in Dept. of VAN, VPB, VMC and ANN.

It was further decided that the inspection report as well as comments received from the applicant University shall also be sent to the Central Government as provided under Rule 9(8) of VCI Rules, 2017.

The Council observed that the Bank Guarantee is in order as provided under Rule 8(2) of VCI Rules, 2017. The applicant college has also submitted evidence towards Fixed Deposit of Rs.2,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crores) for three years equivalent to the estimated salaries payable to faculty proposed to be employed during second academic year in the name of Hon. Shri. Babanrao Pachpute Vichardhara Trust as provided under Rule 8(3) of VCI Rules 2017.

The Committee noted that the Council after following due procedure and inspection of the College recommended Central Government for not issue of Letter of Intent due to non- fulfilment of minimum requirements as laid down under VCI Rules,2017 and VCI Regulations, 2016 under Rule 7(10) of VCI Rules,2017 for the academic session 2026-27. The Central Government has also accepted the recommendation of VCI and decided not to issue LOI in respect of aforesaid applicant for the academic session 2026-27 vide Department letter dated 26.12.2025.

Further, Committee observed that there is no provision in VCI Rules,2017 that after rejection of LOI for a particular academic session shall be reconsidered again.

Hence, Executive Committee noted that the proposal is beyond the purview of VCI Rules,2017.

In view of above, Executive Committee decided that the proposal cannot be considered for the academic session 2026-27 and Central Government may be informed that applicant institution may be advised for submission of fresh application for the academic session 2027-28 as per Schedule provided in VCI Rules,2017."

After detailed deliberation, the Council approved the aforesaid decision of the Executive Committee and decided that the aforesaid decision shall be informed to the Central Government immediately.

89(16) To consider the Letter No.K-12052-6/2/2021-DADF-Dept (19800) dated 17.2.2026 received from the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, New Delhi forwarding therewith the ICAR comments on Draft VCI MSVE-Postgraduate (MVSc/PhD) Regulations, 2025 together with the recommendations made by the Executive Committee in its meeting held on 18/2/2026.

The Council considered the Letter No.K-12052-6/2/2021-DADF-Dept (19800) dated 17.2.2026 received from the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, New Delhi forwarding therewith the ICAR comments on Draft VCI MSVE-Postgraduate (MVSc/PhD) Regulations, 2025 together with the recommendations made by the Executive Committee in its meeting held on 18/2/2026.

The Executive Committee in its meeting held on 18/2/2026 decided as under:

"The Executive Committee considered the Letter No.K-12052-6/2/2021-DADF-Dept (19800) dated 17.2.2026 forwarding therewith the ICAR comments on Draft VCI MSVE-Postgraduate (MVSc/PhD) Regulations, 2025.



The Committee decided that the comments received from the ICAR shall be circulated amongst all the members of the Council for offering their views in the Council meeting to be held on 27.2.2026. It was further decided that Council after receipt of new proposal related to PG Diploma in veterinary Science shall considered from time to time and shall be notified under the Regulations.

The Committee also agreed that for Central Institutions in veterinary science 100% admissions can be made through centralized counselling by the Central Government in the line of medical education which is being conducted by the Ministry of Health, Government of India.

The comments of ICAR shall be sent to the Chairman, Education Committee and they shall incorporate the changes in PG Regulations at the appropriate place."

After detailed deliberation and changes suggested for incorporation, the Council approved the aforesaid decision of the Executive Committee and decided that the appropriate amendment in the Draft Regulations shall be carried out by the Chairman of the Education Committee and after receipt of the final Draft Regulations from the Chairman, Education Committee, the same shall be forwarded to the Central Government for its approval.

89(17) To consider the Letter No.P.(43)/RAJUVAS/Reg./General/2026/50-A dated 16.1.2026 received from the Registrar, Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner regarding decision on students admitted in the year 2024 only on the basis of NEET (UG) Merit together with the decision taken by the Executive Committee in its meeting held on 27/1/2026.

The Council considered the Letter No. P.(43)/RAJUVAS/Reg./General/2026/50-A dated 16.1.2026 received from the Registrar, Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner regarding decision on students admitted in the year 2024 only on the basis of NEET (UG) Merit.

After detailed deliberations, the Council decided that the authorities of the University shall take appropriate action/ decision in consultation with the State Government towards regularization of admission for the academic session 2024-25 in respect of students admitted by the University and their various affiliated veterinary colleges imparting BVSc & AH degree courses at their own level.

89(18) To consider the Letter No.A-1/2025/13015 dated 07.1.2026 received from the Registrar, Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana regarding Migration of Mr. Angad Deep Singh from Apollo College of Veterinary Medicine, Jaipur to College of Veterinary Science, Ludhiana.

The Council considered the Letter No.A-1/2025/13015 dated 07.1.2026 received from the Registrar, Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences



University, Ludhiana regarding Migration of Mr. Angad Deep Singh from Apollo College of Veterinary Medicine, Jaipur to College of Veterinary Science, Ludhiana.

The Council noted that the Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana has not issued No Objection Certificate and no justification. Hence, Council has not considered the matter. Accordingly, the same may be informed to the University.

Further, Council decided that the matter regarding migration shall be listed in agenda only when NOC has been issued by the both Universities (Transferor and Transferee). Hence, Council decided that such case of migration shall not be considered.

The Council considered the Letter No.P.(02)/RAJUVAS/Reg./2020/95 dated 13.2.2026 and Letter No P.(02)/RAJUVAS/Reg./2020/96 dated 13.2.2026 received from the Registrar, Rajasthan Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Bikaner forwarding No Objection Certificate for transfer of Shri Manan Singh Godara and Ms. Chanchal Vyas from College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Navania, Udaipur to College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner.

After detail deliberation, the Council allowed the Transfer of Shri Manan Singh Godara and Ms. Chanchal Vyas from College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Navania, Udaipur to College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Bikaner under Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner.

89(20) To consider the matter regarding Jurisdiction of newly formed Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (Jobner), Jaipur and Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner.

The Council noted that Government of Rajasthan vide Notification dated 14 September, 2023 has formed Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (Jobner), Jaipur by bifurcating of the existing University namely Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner.

Hence, Council considered the matter regarding Jurisdiction of newly formed Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (Jobner), Jaipur and Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner as per the Gazette Notification dated 14 September, 2023 and the request letter of the Universities letter dated 01.12.2025 and 28.1.2026.

Further, Council noted that the BVSc & AH qualification of Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner is considered as recognized in respect of following veterinary colleges and same as included at Sr.no.75 of the First Schedule to the IVC Act, 1984:



As per letter dated 01.12.2025 of RAJUVAS, Jobner (Jaipur), the following recognized veterinary college shall come under the jurisdiction of newly bifurcated established University:

1. Post Graduate Institute of Veterinary Education and Research, Jaipur
2. Arawali Veterinary College, Sikar
3. Mahatma Jyotiba Fule College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Chomu, Jaipur

The Council considered the Letter No.K-12052-3/1/2026-LH (E-40104) dated 20th February, 2026 received from the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi forwarding therewith the copy of the Hon'ble High Court's Order dated 13.02.2026 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 1547/2026 titled 'Srimati Urmila Devi Mahagaiya Paropkari Trust, Bharatpur through Its President vs Union of India & Ors along with representation vide letter No. F.3(A-2)/MGVC/1107 dated 16.02.2026 of Mahatma Gandhi Veterinary College.

The Council noted the order dated 13.2.2026 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 1547/2026 titled 'Srimati Urmila Devi Mahagaiya Paropkari Trust, Bharatpur through Its President vs Union of India & Ors. The Council observed that in similar case filed by M.R. Rural Education Society vide CWP No.30901 of 2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh wherein this Council was also respondent in the matter wherein Hon'ble Court in para 6,7 & 8 has held as under:

"We do not find any error in the decision of the VCI in as much as holding of NEET examination is by the National Testing Agency (NTA) which is uniformly applied and accepted for most of the medical courses throughout the country. We are also of the view that mere appearance in NEET UG



Examination, without qualifying, serves no purpose in as much as the minimum merit of a candidate would be tested based upon the qualification of NEET UG Examination only.

The condition put by the VCI that unqualified NEET UG merit ought not to be made the basis for admission appears to be a reasonable decision. Such decision is, otherwise, in consonance with law.

In such circumstances, we do not find any merit in the writ petition only because in the previous years unqualified NEET students were also allowed to participate."

Hence, Council after detailed deliberation, decided not to relax any minimum eligibility criteria for admission to BVSc & AH course in terms of NEET qualified candidates. Further, Council also noted that the last date of admission to BVSc & AH course was extended by the Central Government upto 10.1.2026 for the academic session 2025-26. Further, new academic session for 2026-27 shall commence from August, 2026 as the extension of last date beyond 10.1.2026 may lead to derailment of academic session 2025-26. Hence, Council decided not to extend any last date of admission beyond 10.1.2026 for academic session 2025-26.

The aforesaid decision/ opinion of the Council shall be conveyed to the Central Government for taking appropriate action in the matter as directed by the Hon'ble Court in the matter.

The Council considered the Letter No.KB/STY/OS/a/c-4208/2024-25 dated 02nd February, 2026 received from M/s Kendriya Bhandar, West Block-VIII, Wing-3, Ground Floor, R.K. Puram, New Delhi regarding release the outstanding payment of Rs.4.54,189/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Four Thousand One Hundred Eighty Nine only) towards supply of Stationary Items (Furniture).

After detailed deliberations, the Council noted that the material has already been supplied in the year 2016 as appraised by the office and payment was not released due to some administrative reasons in the year 2016. Though, expenditure liability were already shown during that year. Therefore, Council after detailed deliberations and in view of management letter given by CAG to VCI, it was decided that the payment shall be released as per their request from VCI Examination Fund for compliance of the CAG so that these outstanding amount could not be shown in the balance sheet of the VCI for the financial year 2025-26.

The visitor report shall specifically address whether previous deficient if any, have been rectified by the College and there have been any changes in the infrastructure, equipment or manpower since the previous inspection report for appointment of Visitor, Council authorized President, VCI for taking necessary action in the matter regarding recommendation of LOP shall be considered by the Council on the basis of Visitor Report.

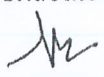
