

## VETERINARY COUNCIL OF INDIA

Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Veterinary Council of India held on 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2026 at 2.30 P.M. (Virtual Mode).

Members namely Dr. Sujit K. Dutta, Dr. P.S. Patel, Dr. Pravin Kumar Deore, Dr. Falguni S. Thakar, Dr. Danjan Longri, Dr. D. Thanigaivelu, Dr. Vasava Kirankumar, Dr. Dandeswar Deka, Dr. Indrajit Singh, and Dr. Vijay Kumar could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, the Secretary, VCI (Addl. Charge) welcomed all the Members of the Veterinary Council of India and meeting commenced with permission of the Chair.

- (1) To consider the representation of Shri Deepak Yadav, a student of B.V.Sc.&A.H (Batch 2020-21), enrolled at International Institute of Veterinary Education & Research (IIVER), Bahu Akbarpur, Rohtak affiliated to Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Science, Hisar for migration to LUVAS, Hisar in pursuant to the Hon'ble High Court order dated April 1, 2026 passed in CWP-23102-2025.

The Council considered the representation of Shri Deepak Yadav, a student of B.V.Sc.&A.H (Batch 2020-21), enrolled at International Institute of Veterinary Education & Research (IIVER), Bahu Akbarpur, Rohtak affiliated to Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Science, Hisar (also Petitioner in CWP No.23102-2025 filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh) along with order dated 01.4.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in the aforesaid writ petition. The Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in CWP No.23102 of 2025 passed the following order on 01.4.2026:

*"Referring to Regulation 11(7) of the Regulations (Annexure P-22), which pertains to the migration or transfer of students, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the respondent No.2- Veterinary Council of India is required to take a conscious and considered decision regarding the*

*petitioner's entitlement to seek migration in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of his course, no such decision has been taken till date.*

*In the considered opinion of this Court, apart from the foregoing issue, another issue arises for consideration as to whether the petitioner can seek migration or transfer from a recognized college to the veterinary college of the respondent No.3- University. For this purpose, Regulation 10 of the Regulations (Annexure P-21), which also governs migration or transfer of students, assumes significance and requires consideration by the respondent No.2. However, the said exercise has not yet been undertaken by the respondent No.2, which, instead, is insisting solely upon a 'No Objection Certificate' from the respective college. Accordingly, at this stage, this Court directs the respondent No.2- Veterinary Council of India to consider the petitioner's case in accordance with the opposite Regulations governing migration or transfer of students and to apprise this Court of its final decision. This exercise shall be completed within a period of four weeks from today.*

*Liston 01.05.2026."*

The Council observed that migration/ transfer of students from one veterinary college to another veterinary college governs under Regulation 10 of VCI – MSVE Regulations, 2016.

The Council also noted that the Petitioner is in fourth B.V.Sc. & AH programme at International Institute of Veterinary Education & Research (IIVER), Bahu Akbarpur, Rohtak which is recognized under the provisions of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 and affiliated college of Respondent No.3 University. After completion of fourth BVSc & AH programme, one year duration of internship programme shall be commenced. Further, Regulation 12(1) of the VCI – MSVE Regulations, 2016 provides as under:

*"Every student of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree course shall be required after passing the fourth professional examination to undergo compulsory rotating internship to the satisfaction of the University for a minimum period of twelve calendar months so as to be eligible for the award of the degree of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry and full registration with the council."*

After detailed deliberations, the Council observed that after completion of fourth BVSc & AH programme, the internship programme shall be commenced under the supervision of University (Respondent No.3) as provided under Regulation 12(1) of the aforesaid Regulations. Hence, there is no merit for migration as requested by the Petitioner from one college to another veterinary college within the same University (Respondent No.3).

The Council further observed that the Petitioner has failed to submit No Objection Certificate from the College where he is presently pursuing the B.V.Sc.&A.H course and the college where he wants migration. This NOC is required in terms of no dues certificates, payment of course fee, transfer of internal marks for

the purpose of inclusion in final marksheet as provided under VCI – MSVE Regulations, 2016.

In view of aforesaid, Council has decided not to allow migration of the Petitioner from International Institute of Veterinary Education & Research (IIVER), Bahu Akbarpur, Rohtak to another veterinary College of the Respondent No.3 (University).

The aforesaid decision shall be conveyed to the Hon'ble High Court through Central Government Standing Counsel.
